## What is the Social Support Service for Multicultural Communities?

Social Support for Multicultural Communities is designed to assist older people, people with a disability and their carers to continue living independently at home through the provision of flexible and responsive social services. These include:

- Visiting individuals in their homes
- Assisting with shopping and related tasks
- Accompanying individuals to medical and other appointments
- Supporting individuals to connect or reconnect with social groups, activities or hobbies

## Who Can Access the Service?

You may be able to access this service if you:

- are from a diverse cultural (or multicultural) background
- are an older person or have a moderate to severe disability
- live in the Hornsby, Hunters Hill, Ku-ring-gai or Ryde Local Government Areas
