Lindsay Gardens (Hamilton)

Lindsay Gardens is situated in a quiet street in Hamilton, only minutes to Beaumont Street's famous shops, cafes and restaurants. The facility is home to 65 residents in total, with 32 high care residents, 15 low care residents, and 18 dementia or memory loss residents. Lindsay Gardens is an Ageing-In-Place facility, who can attend to the individual needs of every resident regardless of their care requirements.

Lindsay Gardens is both a high care facility and low care facility, and offers a modern home-like environment for residents in a spacious, colourful and caring setting. There are many private lounge and dining areas as well as a large common room for major functions and celebrations. The beautiful shaded and landscaped courtyards provide enjoyable views and surrounds for residents to enjoy.

The accommodation is homely and spacious, with each resident having their own single bedroom. Each bedroom has an ensuite with handrails, an emergency call system, air conditioning, picture rails and built-in wardrobe, all within a secure building.
