Corella Cottage Dementia Day Respite

Corella Cottage is a day program for people over the age of 65 years with a cognitive impairment. It provides a unique opportunity for individuals to engage with other people in a safe supportive homelike environment. The program is designed to support health and wellbeing through a focus on social participation, independence, and quality of life. The service is provided at Bateau Bay seven days a week and Warnervale six days a week.

How do I access the service?

Do I need a referral?

Referrals can be made by anyone including yourself.

What types of support can be provided?

You can enjoy the company of others in a safe, relaxed and enjoyable environment whilst participating in leisure and lifestyle activities including:

- Supervised gentle exercise
- Music Appreciation
- Leisure and lifestyle activities
- Social support

What are the costs?

There is a fee to attend Corella Cottage. People who may feel financially disadvantaged are not excluded from receiving services, and should discuss this matter with the Coordinator.
