What are Community Aged Care Packages (CACP)?

Community Aged Care Packages (CACP) are a government-funded service to support older people who wish to remain at home. Each care package is personalised to your needs and can include the following services:

- Meal preparation
- Personal care
- Light housework
- Shopping
- Transport to appointments
- Outings
- Respite for carers
- Linking to other services and advocacy

Who can access the service?

Any person who has been assessed as suitable by an Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT). Your GP can refer you to the ACAT for your Local Government Area (LGA). Contact details are available from your local Public Hospital.

Pastoral care

How are services arranged?

One of our Case Managers will visit you at home to discuss your needs and develop a plan of care. Regular services are planned and are flexible to change as your needs change.

A number of our care staff provide service and support to the Chinese and Italian aged communities.

How much does the service cost?

You will be asked to pay an affordable weekly fee for the Community Aged Care Package. People will not be excluded from this service due to an inability to pay.
