What are Extended Aged Care At Home - Dementia (EACH-D) Packages?

Extended Aged Care at Home - Dementia (EACH-D) packages are individually planned and coordinated packages of care, tailored to support older people with dementia and high level care needs to remain at home.

Extended Aged Care at Home Dementia (EACH-D) packages provide the same full range of services that EACH packages provide including:

- registered nursing care
- care by an allied health professional such as a physiotherapist or podiatrist
- personal care
- transport to appointments
- social support
- home help.

EACH-D packages also offer service approaches and strategies to meet the specific needs of care recipients with dementia who experience behaviours which may impact their daily quality of life.

Who Can Access the Service?

Any person who has been assessed as requiring high level care by an Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT). Your GP can refer you to the ACAT for your Local Government Area (LGA). Contact details are also available from your local public hospital.

UnitingCare Ageing provides EACH-D packages in the Northern Beaches.

Pastoral care

UnitingCare Ageing also offers pastoral counselling, visiting and prayer support.

How are services arranged?

One of our Case Managers will visit you at home to discuss your needs and develop a plan of care. Regular services are planned and are flexible to change as your needs change.

How much does the service cost?

You will be asked to pay an affordable weekly fee for the EACH-D Package. People will not be excluded from this service due to an inability to pay.
